PRIMARY PURPOSE OF POSITION

The Oracle EBS Application DBA will be responsible for the implementation, support, patching and tuning of the EBS Oracle Suite.

- Oracle Application Server and Oracle Database administration.
- Configuration and tuning of the EBS environment including concurrent managers, work flow, application servers and databases.
- Assist the functional team in troubleshooting and optimizing interface points with SOA, B2B, Discoverer and Siebel.
- Support for production and non-production / Disaster Recovery environments.

This position will be part of a DBA team providing support for a 24x7 highly available Oracle EBS environment.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

The Oracle EBS Application DBA will be responsible for the continuous improvement of the Oracle EBS database and application server environment.

- Work closely with the functional and development teams to support the Oracle EBS suite.
- Participate in the release management process to coordinate any updates, patches or cross functional issues.
- Work with Oracle support to provide timely resolution to open service requests.
- Responsible for maintaining production as well as non-production environment. Patching, Cloning, code migration,
- Participate in on-call rotation.
